Properties purchased at Tax Sale

The property on Cesale Street Account # 03813029 was inspected for contents. Ideas were floated and the consensus was that the contents will be placed at curbside for collection during the Spring Cleanup (May 22nd to the 25th). It is planned that since the building is beyond reasonable repair costs that it should be demolished after all contents have been removed.

Strait of Canso Superport Letter of Support

Heavy Trucks

The matter of heavy truck traffic was brought up during the gallery session. C'lr Russell noted unsafe encounters with trucks at the Morrison Lake exit point and suggested that the owner of the quarry and scale house personnel be contacted and to follow up on this continuing concern. Mayor Hadley noted he was in contact with the manager and expressed his concerns. C'lr Chisholm in line with C'lr Russell's comments suggested that a further follow up be pursued by requesting a meeting with the site manager and scale house management.
